After 14 years of service, Shelley Vollmer, Washington, has retired from her position on the Board of Directors for Public Water Supply District (PWSD) No. 1 of Franklin County, which provides water service for more than 1,600 customers and sewer service to some 600 customers in the north-central portion of Franklin County between Washington and Union.

A graduate of Washington High School and owner of Wimpy's Sandwich Shop in Washington, Vollmer joined the water district board in 2011 as Director for Sub-District No. 4. During her tenure, the water district completed more than 20 improvement projects, including:

- Major Upgrades to the distribution system from the city limits of Washington to Hwy 50 West on Hwy BB.
- Upgrades to the elevated storage, wells and pumps at the Country Club Tower and High Ridge Stand pipe.
- Improvements to the Krakow Wastewater Treatment Facility
- Upgrades to sewage collections system in Emerald City
- Many developer additions to the sewer and water system; and

provided oversite for monthly system maintenance and trouble shooting.

Joe Feldmann, President of the Board of Directors, for PWSD #1 described Shelley as a fearless proponent for the district. "Shelley's 'no nonsense' approach to problem solving and her business knowledge were highly regarded during her tenure with the board and will be missed."

Shelley's position will be filled by Greg Hoberock.

Vollmer is a graduate of East Central College and Missouri Baptist University. She is active in the Washington community, serving in numerous volunteer positions, including the Washington Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors, Washington Town & Country Fair and the annual GoFund Charity Golf Classic. She also serves as bookkeeper for American Legion Post 218.
